Uncirculated Bullion Silver Eagles are struck without a mint mark. From 1986-1999, these coins were struck at the Philadelphia Mint. In 2000, their production was moved to the West Point facility. Since 2011, the coins have been struck at both the San Francisco and West Point Mints.

Burnished: Since 2006, special-issue "burnished" American Silver Eagles have been released. Burnished coins are made to exacting standards using a special minting process. Each coin is struck on a special hand fed, burnished (polished) blank, giving it a unique shimmering finish.
